Incident Reports

- Custodian: taking trash out at MS. When throwing out, cut fingers on tin can. Advised to put sharps in something besides trash can.
- Bus drivers (multiple): yak tracks ordered for bus drivers. They are required to wear them. Ice between buses an issue. Advised to fill out accident report immediately, and also post signage in area.
- MS: Teacher walking in foot of snow and fell on hidden ice. Suggested buying some traction devices for shoes.
- MS: Advice-when removing snow, staff hurt self when removing snow. Advice: use safe lifting techniques and fill out accident report at time of accident.
- CR: Sat down on back of chair and it broke. Replace chair.
- MS: Custodian slipped and fell. Recommend safety device for shoes.
- BB: Recess duty. Slipped and hurt both shoulders, knee, neck, and central and lower back. Recommended removal shoe grips.
