Kindergarten registration begins in April

Barnes Butte and Crooked River elementary schools will host Kindergarten Round-Up events

Local families with children who will be 5 years old before Sept. 1, 2020, should register their students for school during Crook County School District Kindergarten Round-Up.

The district will host Kindergarten Round-Up twice in April. Families may attend the event that best fits their schedule.

The first registration event is planned for 5:30 to 7 p.m. Thursday, April 16 at Crooked River Elementary, 1400 SE Second St. in Prineville.

The second event will be held at Barnes Butte Elementary, 1875 NE Iron Horse Drive, from 5:30 to 7 p.m. Thursday, April 30.

Families must bring a document that provides proof of the child's age, such as a birth certificate, hospital records or baptismal records. They also must bring proof of residency, such as a utility bill or official mail, as well as current immunization records and emergency phone numbers.

Interpreters will be present at both events.

If families are unsure which school their incoming Kindergartner will attend, they may call the school secretaries.
