1.0 Opening  
Deen Hylton called the meeting to order at 3:18 pm.

2.0 Approval of February 19<sup>th</sup> Meeting Minutes

Beth Lampert moved and Cyndee Rizzardini seconded to approve the minutes as written. The committee voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

3.0 Review of Active Shooter Presentation and Current Lockdown Procedures and School Alert Presentation  
Deen asked for input from the committee on the School Alert presentation by Heather Weissinger at the February meeting. Discussion followed regarding the basic use of the system, the initial cost to install, and the current lockdown procedures in the buildings.

Deen explained that with the upgrades to the existing buildings and the new elementary, cameras and remote operated door locks would make the School Alert system more efficient. Much discussion followed regarding whether our current procedures were in line with current Law Enforcement practices.

The committee members agreed that it would be beneficial for all staff to see the presentation by Capt. Boyd and SRO Jeff Coffman regarding Active Shooter training. It was suggested that instead of an all staff presentation, that each building has its own presentation.


4.0 Committee recommendation to Administrative Team

Dawna Sundberg moved and Michelle Powers seconded the following recommendations to be presented to the Administrative team at their next meeting:


1. Re-evaluate the current district policies surrounding school lockdowns/active shooter/intruder emergencies and bring it into line with current Law Enforcement recommendations.
2. After new security cameras and remotely activated door locks are in place, re-evaluate the potential purchase of a lockdown software system. (one building may be selected as a "trial run")
