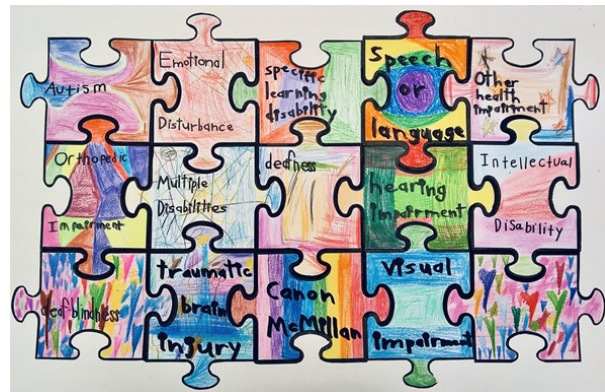


K-3 STUDENTS BACK IN THE CLASSROOMS?
