Dear Valued Parents,

With the Labor Day Weekend upon us and many of you planning to enjoy time with family and friends, we wanted to send you a quick update as the official first day of school is only a few days away. Our goal is to keep you in the loop as information changes.

Your Crook County School Board met today to discuss the potential opening of school for 4<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades if we meet the state and local county metrics. K-3 has already met the metrics and will begin school next week. 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> graders will start September 8<sup>th</sup> and Kindergartners on September 14<sup>th</sup>.

Here is what the school board decided:

## **POTENTIAL OPENING OF 4<sup>TH</sup> – 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADES**

- The School Board voted today to open our schools to all K-12 students as soon as possible provided all state metrics are and all safety protocols and guidelines are met
- The earliest potential date of opening for 4<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> students is **Monday, September 14<sup>th</sup>**
- The School District will give staff and families 1-week notice before opening
- Expected next update for Covid-19 Metrics is September 8<sup>th</sup>
- Online options are still available for families who don't feel comfortable sending their children to school. Contact your child's school for more information.
- Parents can expect to receive additional information from their child's school, including a more detailed schedule and building information.

## **HYBRID LEARNING CAMPUS AT PIONEER**
