SCHOOL CALENDAR ALERT!

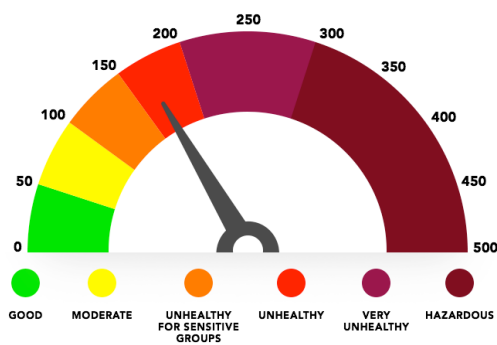

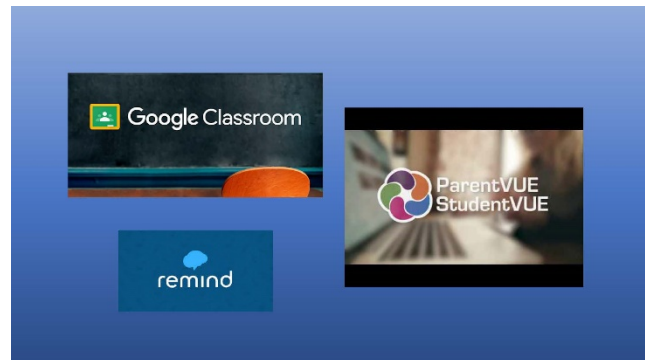


AIR QUALITY ALERT FOR NEXT WEEK
